

## Cumberland Youth Hockey Summer 2009 News Letter

The board members have been busy planning summer fundraisers!!! This summer the association will be doing 2 major fundraisers.

The first one being a 2009 V-Rod Harley Davidson, it is red in color, sharp looking bike!!!! Costs for the tickets are \$25.00 for one or \$100.00 for five. The drawing will be held at Louis Meats on Monday September 7, 2009 (Labor Day). You will be contacted by a board member to help sell tickets. The board has decided take "Harley" to different events in Cumberland this summer to sell tickets, as well as on weekends in town. Selling tickets will count for work hours. The selling hours could be from 10:00 A.M. until 3:00 P.M or 4:00 P.M. at each location. Work hours will be 25 hours per family again this year. If you are interested in selling tickets or purchasing them for yourself please contact any board members.

The second fundraiser is the Truck and Tractor pull during Rutabaga Fest. The tractors will run on Friday August 28 and the trucks will run on Saturday August 29, 2009. The track is already built and looks great. We will need workers to run concession stand, selling Harley tickets and who knows what else. This will be an annual event for the association.

Under the pulling idea for fundraisers we will be also putting on a Garden Tractor Pull on August 15, 2009 at 1:00 P.M. and an ATV pull also on this date. Here again this would be a great chance to get some work hours in and done. Work hours will be 25 hours per family again. (In case you forgot!!!)

All these fundraisers will take everyone's help and support. We realize that summers are packed with many fun times. It is vital that these events are successful to keep the association running smoothly and looking good. This coming season the association will be hosting the Squirt State Tournament. This will also be a great chance for us to make some money for the association, show off our arena and community.

### REGISTRATION INFORMATION AND CALENDAR SALES

We will also be holding registration on September 16 and 17 2009 from 4:00 to 8:00 p.m. at the hockey rink. Then again on Saturday September 26, 2009 also at the rink from 9:00 to 11:00. You will need to register on line at the following website [www.waha-hockey.com](http://www.waha-hockey.com), then click onto register USA Hockey on line.

This has to be done before coming to registration at the rink. This is the only way you will be able to register for USA Hockey.

The registration will be the same as last years.

Atom: Free unless over age 5 then it is a \$40.00 WAHA fee.

Mites: \$175.00          Squirts: \$ 200.00

Peewee: \$250.00        Girls: \$275.75

The amount for registration must be paid in full before the 2<sup>nd</sup> registration date or there will be a late fee of \$50.00. The full amount will be paid before the skater can get on the ice for the first practice.

In addition to this you will have to write 2 separate checks. The first check would be for work hours. (\$250.00) Work hours will be for all levels of skaters including first year. The next check will be for \$670.00 for calendar sales. These checks will be per family. For a total amount of \$920.00 per family. **The calendar sales check will be held on until December 1, 2009. The work hour check will be held until March 1, 2010.** On those dates your requirements are met (All calendars turned in with all money and all work hours completed) your check will be returned to you. If your calendars or work hours are not completed your check will be cashed. If you have sold some of the calendars and some work hours you will need to write a check for the difference. If a check is not written for the difference then the association will cash your check for the entire amount. If you write a check for the difference, the association will gladly return the original check. These checks will also be written out before the skater can get on the ice for the first practice. Coaches with a child in hockey will also need to do calendar sales. Their work hours are met with coaching. If you are coming from another association you will be asked to sell 10 calendars and pay full registration.
